INBOUND-STUDENT REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICATION

1. REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICATION:

1. A cumulative GPA of no less than 2.75
2. A valid English language proficiency test scores (native English speakers will be exempted):
 - 1) TOEFL: not lower than 61 (internet-based) / not lower than 500 (paper-based) or
 - 2) IELTS: not lower than 5 overall or
 - 3) A letter from home university certifying for the student's English-language proficiency.

2. SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

- 1) A passport photo with white background
- 2) A reference letter from home university academic advisor
- 3) An official academic transcript
- 4) A copy of the first page of the applicant's passport
- 5) An SOP or Statement of Purpose (500-800 words)
- 6) A list of courses of interest the applicant would like to study at PSU.

7. APPLICATION PROCESS

- Home University will send a list of nominated students with their essential information and contact details to innoEM.
- Nominated candidates will receive application instructions from innoEM and must complete the application by the announced application deadline.
- innoEM will process the candidates' application and send the letter of acceptance to their home university (the letter is for visa application).

8. VISA AND IMMIGRATION INFORMATION VISA EXTENSION

- All inbound students must acquire a Non-Immigration Visa "ED" (Education) prior to their arrival.
- For the first entry with student visa, the maximum period of stay will be 90 days. Students can extend their student visa by contacting innoEM at least one month before its expiry date.
- Those who failed to extend and/or overstay their visas may face charges and penalties:
- The fine for overstaying is 500 THB per day, a maximum fine of 20,000 THB will be applied for 40 or more days.
- Those who are overstaying for over 90 days could be banned from entering the Kingdom of Thailand in the future.

9. ACCOMMODATIONS
